Your email address has not been, will not be shared with third parties. In the event that no action is taken by you we will continue to send our communications.

1. Cookies

Cookies are small text files that the sites save on your computer or on your mobile / tablet when you visit them. Thanks to cookies, the site is able to store some data and parameters useful for navigation (eg login, language or text size etc ..) so that you do not have to enter your data again or change some settings when you return to an already visited site or change pages while browsing.

On this site, we use technical cookies for:

Our site hosts a blog, at the end of each post there are buttons to share content on social networks Facebook, Twitter, LinkedIn and others listed below.

All these platforms save data on their servers that may reside outside the EU and use their own cookies to recognize you, if you are surfing after logging into your accounts.

We have no agreements with any of them and we can not control how they use your data. For more information, please read their privacy policy:

Our site DOES NOT use Google Analytics to analyze visitor data (read point 5).

You can set up your browser to prevent cookies from being stored.

We inform you that you can install this component, developed by Google, to block the use of Google Analytics .

2. Blog

Our site hosts a blog where we talk about art and review works of art, mainly by the Ukrainian artist Svyatoslav Ryabkin or other artists to whom we have previously requested permission. We also talk about cultural events and / or art exhibitions always asking for prior authorization of those directly involved according to current regulations.

We normally send an email every 60 days to our members.

Blog posts are automatically sent by e-mail to our subscribers, if you are already registered and no longer wish to receive

them, simply unsubscribe by clicking on the link in each email sent. Alternatively you can always reply to each one mail received indicating the desire to no longer want to receive our communications, your message will be delivered to our technical staff who will provide as soon as possible.

Comments on our blogs are moderated before being published. The management of comments is entrusted to Disqus. You will be asked from time to time to accept their Terms of Service, their privacy policy and their Data Sharing Policy. Every time you publish a comment all the data you enter they will be managed by the Disqus platform.

3. Newsletter

Our newsletter service allows us to inform you on the art exhibitions we organize.

The number of emails sent varies depending on the events that our staff can organize. In the year 2017 we sent 7 emails to our members.

The newsletter is managed by Wix, your email address is stored on Wix servers (even outside the EU) and, occasionally, in backups hosted on Gmail. You can read the Wix privacy policy by clicking on this link .

Wix Shoutcast, like many newsletter management platforms, provides information on who opens the newsletter and clicks on the links; we use this information to understand if our subscribers follow us and if they are interested in reading our communications.

4. Use of the contact form (data entered in comments or contacts)

If you contact us through the " Contact " section of the site, we will use your own data to answer you, in the same way if you contact us by e-mail or leave a comment in a post. Your data remain stored in our e-mail archives (Gmail) e in the site database (hosted on Wix.com). The owner and the person in charge of data processing is indicated in our "Privacy Policy" a [this link](#) . Your data are NOT transferred to another person or company for any reason. If in your message you said you want to receive our updates, or if you have ticked the "Join to our newsletter," from the "Contact" form, you will be placed in our mailing list.

5. Navigation on the site

Our site does not use services such as Google Analytics or similar services external to those integrated within the platform provided by Wix.com, if in the future we decide to activate them this section and this document will be promptly updated.

6. Duration, cancellation and data holder

The data controller is indicated in our Privacy Policy (see link in point 4).

We do not give your email address to anyone else, for any reason (should any special case arise, we will always ask for your explicit consent); you can stop receiving the newsletter at any time, through the link at the bottom of each message we receive. We will continue to send you our newsletters and blog posts until you close your subscription using the methods already mentioned. After the

cancellation, Wix still maintains the data of the former members to avoid being able to re-enter them in the mailing list. However, if you prefer to opt for the final and immediate cancellation of ALL the Vs. data, contact us by e-mail and our technical staff will manually and as quickly as possible to cancel some data.
